ORDER

On September 12, 2022, the Court held a telephonic conference regarding case management issues on Plaintiff's Emergency Motion for a Temporary Restraining Order and a Preliminary Injunction ("Emergency Motion") (Dkt. ORDERED that the Parties' Motions to Appear Pro Hac Vice (Dkt. Nos. 12, 13, 23, 24) are GRANTED; it is further

ORDERED that Plaintiff shall file a response, if any, to Defendant's Motion to Dismiss (Dkt. No. 14) by 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, September 13, 2022; it is further

ORDERED that Plaintiff shall file a reply, if any, to Defendant's response to Plaintiff's Emergency Motion (Dkt. No. 4) by 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, September 13, 2022, which shall be no

longer than ten pages in length; it is further

ORDERED that Defendant shall file a reply, if any, to Plaintiff's response to Defendant's Motion to Dismiss (Dkt. No. 14) by 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday, September 14, 2022, which shall be no longer than ten pages in length; and it is further

ORDERED that this Court shall hold a hearing in Courtroom 400 at 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, September 15, 2022, on the merits of all outstanding motions.
